
Level 4 Associate Project Manager.

Project managers are responsible for overseeing complex projects, driving organisational change, influencing key stakeholders and utilising the latest technologies to support their objectives. This programme will help you to develop the skills, knowledge and experience to be an effective project manager. You will learn how to detail key markers within a project and understand the elements of successful project execution, including communication and team working attributes, for smoother project delivery.

To apply for this programme you must be employed in a relevant role, and, as a minimum requirement, have:

- Five GCSEs with grades 9 to 4 (A* to C), including English and maths
- We also recommend that learners have 48+ UCAS points or equivalent, but suitable work experience (2+ years supporting project delivery) will be considered as an alternative
