
The Level 3 Paralegal Apprenticeship is designed to equip you to work competently within the ethical and regulatory framework required for practice as a paralegal. The programme is designed to build technical skills and expertise, including legal research, drafting documents, communicating clearly, both orally and in writing, and analysing and assessing information. You'll also gain sufficient knowledge of one area of legal practice to enable you to conduct relevant paralegal work under supervision.

To apply for this programme you must be employed in a relevant role, and, as a minimum requirement, have:

- · Three A-Levels equivalent to 96 UCAS points
- Five GCSEs with grades 9 to 4 (A* to C), including English and maths, plus any additional employer requirements
