CII Diploma Insurance Fundamentals (IF) pathway

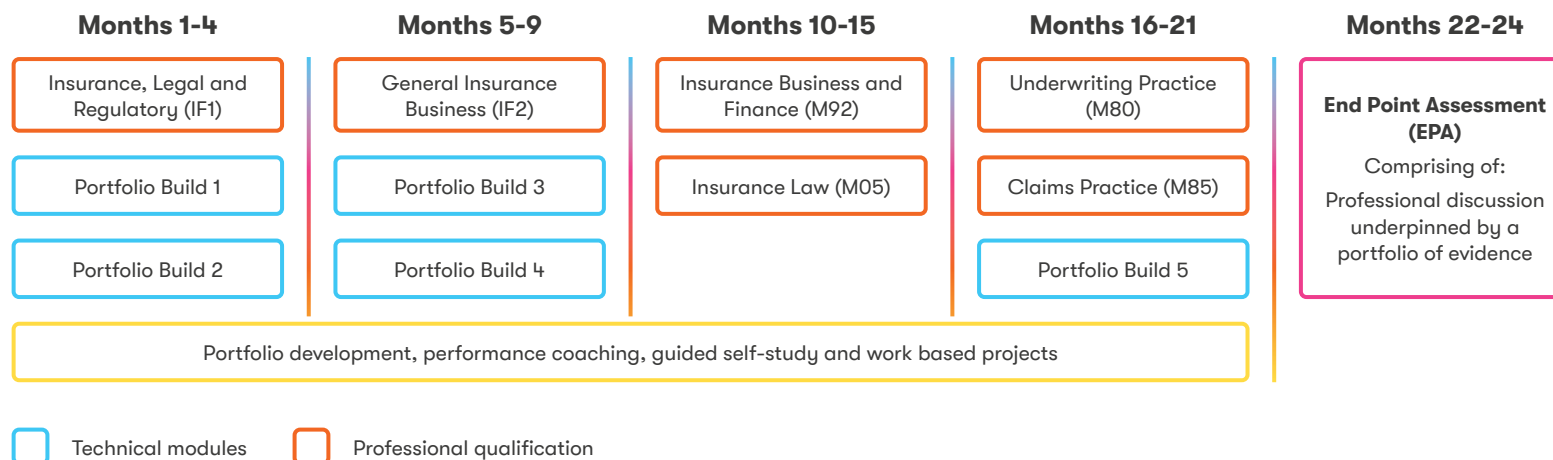

Built around the Chartered Insurance Institute (CII) Diploma, you can choose between an Insurance Fundamentals (IF) or a London Markets (LM) pathway. You'll learn how to build professional relationships within the context of the insurance and regulatory frameworks. In addition, you'll be able to transfer your skills and competencies across the financial services industry for flexibility to support your future career.

We strongly recommend that you speak to your employer about which pathway is the most appropriate for your role.

To apply for this programme you must be employed in a relevant role and, as a minimum requirement, have:

- At least 12 months industry experience, or
- Be educated to degree level, and
- Five GCSEs with grades 9 to 4 (A* to C), including English and maths

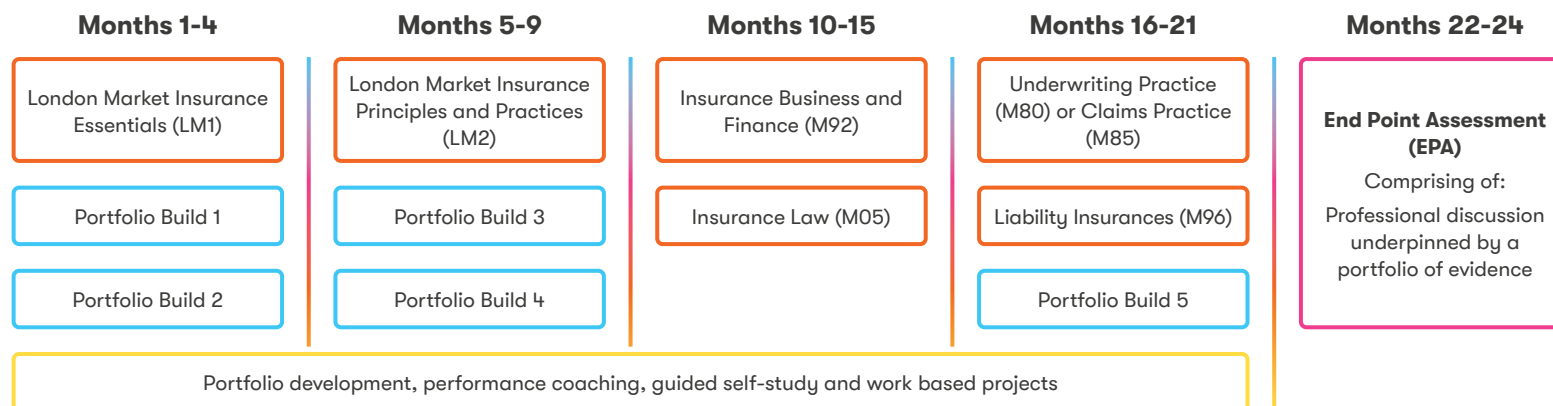
